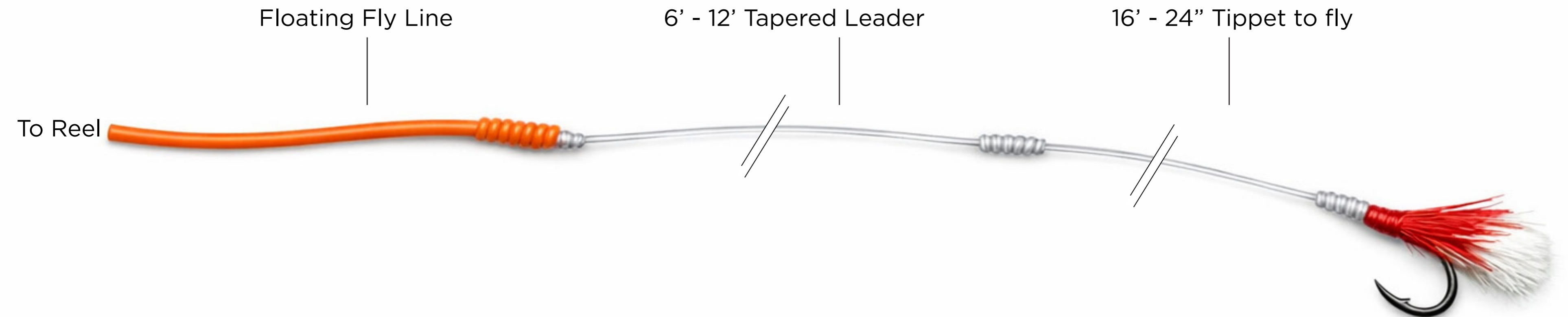


North Shore General Fly Line Set-up



Fly Line: use a weight forward floating line to match the line weight of your rod. We recommend an 8 weight fly rod as a good starting point. Using a fly line that works well under cold conditions is helpful.

Leader: packaged tapered leaders are easy to use. A length around 7' is a good start. 2x, or 10lb. in size/weight. It should be a size/weight large than your tippet.

Tippet: 8lb. maxima clear, ultragreen, or fluorocarbon is a good place to start. You can go lighter or heavier if you prefer. Any decent abrasion resistant monofilament should get the job done.

Note: These are intended as general recommendations only. We encourage you to experiment and modify to fit changing conditions, fly type, or technique. We recommend lighter setups for fall coasters, pinks, and coho salmon.
